ADMINISTRATIVE DECERTIFICATION

Summary

On August 31, 2024, The Delaware Police Officers Standards and Training Commission (POST) received notification that Mr. Hume had “been found, after examination by a licensed psychologist or psychiatrist, to be psychologically or emotionally unfit to perform the duties or exercise the powers and authority of a police officer”, which served as grounds for de-certification under 11 Del. C. § 8404(a)(4)d.

Pursuant to 11 Del. C. § 8404A, Mr. Hume had the right to a hearing before a board composed of three Commission members (a 'Hearing Board') appointed by the Commission Chairman. POST notified Mr. Hume of his right to exercise this option; however, no response was received. At the quarterly POST Commission meeting held on November 19, 2024, the Commission reviewed the facts of the case and voted to decertify Mr. Hume, as a police officer in the State of Delaware. As of that date, he is no longer authorized to exercise any police powers in the State of Delaware or be employed by any Delaware law enforcement agency in a police capacity.
