ADMINISTRATIVE DECERTIFICATION

Summary

On April 20, 2022, The Delaware Police Officers Standards and Training Commission (POST) received notification that Ms. Rosado had “Been discharged from employment with a law-enforcement agency for a breach of internal discipline,” which served as grounds for de-certification under 11 Del. C. § 8404(a)(4)e.1.

On November 18, 2021, Ms. Rosado was charged with burglary in the first degree, assault in the third degree, unlawful imprisonment in the second degree, and offensive touching. On May 2, 2023, Ms. Rosado pled guilty to assault in the third degree.

Pursuant to 11 Del. C. § 8404A, Ms. Rosado had the right to a hearing before a board composed of three Commission members (a 'Hearing Board') appointed by the Commission Chairman. POST notified Ms. Rosado of her right to exercise her option; however, no response was received. At the quarterly POST Commission meeting held on August 12, 2025, the Commission reviewed the facts of the case and voted to decertify Ms. Rosado, as a police officer in the State of Delaware. As of that date, she is no longer authorized to exercise any police powers in the State of Delaware or be employed by any Delaware law enforcement agency in a police capacity.
