ADMINISTRATIVE DECERTIFICATION

Summary

On September 15, 2025, the Delaware Police Officer Standards and Training Commission (POST) received notification that Mr. Glaeser had "been found, after examination by a licensed psychologist or psychiatrist, to be psychologically or emotionally unfit to perform the duties or exercise the powers and authority of a police officer," which served as grounds for decertification under 11 Del. C. § 8404(a)(4)d.

Pursuant to 11 Del. C. § 8404A, Mr. Glaeser had the right to a hearing before a board composed of three Commission members (a "Hearing Board") appointed by the Commission Chairman. POST notified Mr. Glaeser of his right to exercise his option; however, Mr. Glaeser provided notice that he wished to voluntarily surrender his POST certification. At the quarterly POST Commission meeting held on May 18, 2026, the Commission reviewed the facts of the case and voted to accept the voluntary relinquishment of his POST certification. As of that date, he is no longer authorized to exercise any police powers in the State of Delaware or be employed by any Delaware law enforcement agency in a police capacity.
